Bluefield, WV- Robert Douglas "Bob" Day, Sr., 67, of Bluefield, WV died Friday September 4, 2009 in a Bluefield hospital. Born May 15, 1942 in Herndon, WV, he was a son of the late Robert Lewis Day and Virginia Louise Ellison Day. Mr. Day served 12 years in the U.S. Navy, where he saw three tours of Vietnam and also toured during the Cuban Missile Crisis. He had lived in Bluefield for most of his life and was of the Christian faith. Mr. Day retired from the Bluefield Post Office as a Supervisor and during retirement, he worked in the sporting goods department at Wal-Mart. He was an avid fisherman and enjoyed hunting. He was a former member of the Triangle Sportsman Club.
