Bluefield, WV- Robert Vincent Kelley, of Bluefield, WV, died Sunday January 30, 2011. Born June 20, 1916 in Latrobe, PA, he was a son of the late Honorable Augustine Bernard Kelley, member of Congress and Ella Bates Kelley of Chevy Chase, MD. Mr. Kelley was a veteran of World War II, having served in the U.S. Marine Corps. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Bluefield. He earned his undergraduate degree in Mining Engineering from Pennsylvania State University and retired from Aeroquip Corporation. He was a past member of the Bluefield, WV Rotary Club, a member and member of the Board of Directors of the former Bluefield Country Club, the Bluefield Elks Club and was also a member of The Round Table. Mr. Kelley was an avid golfer. In addition to his parents, Mr. Kelley was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Stone Posey Kelley in December 2010; and two brothers, A. Regis Kelley of Bethesda, MD and Richard B. Kelley of Garnett Park, MD. Survivors include three children, Katherine Posey Kelley of Wheaton, MD, David B.
