Bluefield, WV - Steve Colo, 90, of 644 Albemarle Street, Bluefield, WV, died Friday June 15, 2012 at a Bluefield Hospital. Born June 7, 1922 at McDowell, WV, he was a son of the late Antonio Cagliostro (Colo) and Rosa Siriano Colo. Mr. Colo owned and operated "Steve's Market" in Keystone WV for over 40 years, where was known as "Mr. Steve". Mr. Colo was a U.S. Army Infantry veteran of World War II serving in Europe where he took part in the capture of the Ludendorff Bridge at Remagen. He was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Bluefield, and loved time spent with his family and many friends. He enjoyed working in his garden and watching WVU, and the Atlanta Braves play. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Anna on November 22, 2010, a sister, Fanny and brothers Mickey and Johnny. Survivors include a sister Teresa Colo of Bluefield, four children Rosa Lee Colo Francy and her husband Clark of Toronto, Ohio, Steve Colo, Jr. (DeeDee) and his wife Marsha of Beckley, WV, Michael Colo of Beckley WV and Tony Colo and his wife Martha of Vinton, VA, and 11 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren.
