Bluefield, WV - Teddy Ray Largen, 70, of Bluefield, formerly of Ridgeway, Va., died at home on Jan. 18, 2009 after a long illness. He was born in Laurel Fork, Carroll County, Va., on Oct. 6, 1938, a son of the late Ray Largen and Winnie Thomas Largen. Ted served in the 101st Airborne Division of the U.S. Army at Ft. Campbell, Ky. He married Mary Mathis on March 2, 1963 in Ft. Campbell. After an honorable discharge, he chose a career in public service as a firefighter. He retired from the City of Martinsville, Va., Fire Department as Assistant Fire Chief after 29 years of service. Ted was active in coaching youth baseball for many years. Ted and his wife moved to Bluefield in November of 2007. He was a member of Cumberland Heights Baptist Church in Bluefield. In addition to his parents, Ted was preceded in death by his brother, Michial Largen, and a sister, Willadean Nester. Survivors include his wife of 46 years, Mary Largen of the home; two sons and their families, Wayne and Ginger Largen and their children, Matthew and Christopher, of Abingdon, Va., and Tim and Cynthia Largen and their children, Jackson and Emma, of Bluefield; one sister, Lula Mae Massey and her husband David of Bassett, Va.; one brother-in-law, Raymond Bobo of Hermitage, Tenn.; and one sister-in-law, Sue Mathis of Cadiz, Ky.
