Tiraah Elizabeth Hunt was born on April 2, 1982 in Bluefield, WV. Tiraah transitioned this life for eternity on Sunday, October 27, 2024 in Bluefield, WV at the age of 42. Tiraah received her early education through Mercer County Schools where she was a graduate of Bluefield High School. Tiraah attended East Tennessee State; Bluefield State College and received her Regents of Bachelor of Arts Degree; Concord University where she studied Psychology and obtained her Master of Social Work Degree.

Tiraah was a loving, caring individual and a devoted child of God. Her life was a living embodiment of kindness and dedication to her faith and family.
