“ Dear Kathy and family,

I just learned from Facebook this morning (Feb. 5) of Bruce's passing. What a shock. I'm so sorry for you loss, and feel it deeply. Bruce was one of my best childhood friends.

We go way back. We lived on opposite ends of Verdun Heights and were elementary school playmates. The most carefree days of my life were those spent with Bruce around the age of 8. We'd leave our respective houses barefoot and shirtless, play outside until noon, have lunch at his house or mine, and then play all day until a parent called us to dinner. If the weather was bad, we spend most of the day inside playing monopoly for countless hours. As we got older, we graduated to chess and built forts. In the winters we sledged, Bruce narrowly avoiding disaster when he hit the corner of an outdoor stone fireplace. I was with Bruce the day his beloved dog and companion Biscuit was shot and killed in our neighborhood. We never found out for sure who did it or why. It was heartbreaking. Bruce loved that dog so much, an vice versa.

When we were 8 or 9 Bruce's dad took us on our first airplane ride. We flew from Bluefield to Roanoke on a Piedmont DC3 just for the heck of it. Landed, turned around and came straight back. It was such a thrill I've never lost my love of airplanes. Another time Doug, Sr. took us on a business trip to wild and wooly Inez, KY, if memory serves. That was an education all in itself.

Bruce's home was mine, and mine was his. We lost touch in later years as I moved from Bluefield and moved around a lot. But I will always cherish our times together. Bruce was so light-hearted and ready with a laugh. We had some great times together.
