Bluefield, VA- William Daniel Cline, Sr. 67, of Bluefield, VA, died Tuesday October 13, 2015 at Bluefield Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Cline was born November 24, 1947 in Welch, WV. He was of the Methodist faith and had last attended Cumberland Heights Baptist Church. He served six years in the Army National Guard at the Welch detachment. Mr. Cline was a Mason at the McDowell Lodge #112.
